**Two Conferences, One Great Deal:
\$200 rebate offered to those who register for WaterSmart Innovations '09
and CA-NV AWWA Fall '09 conferences**

LAS VEGAS (June 8) – Organizers of the second WaterSmart Innovations Conference and Exposition and the California-Nevada Section of the American Water Works Association's 2009 Fall Conference are offering a \$200 rebate to those registered for both conferences, to be held in October in Las Vegas.

The CA-NV AWWA Fall Conference will be held October 5-8 at the Riviera Hotel & Casino; WSI '09 is slated for October 7-9 at the South Point Hotel and Conference Center.

To qualify for the refund, attendees who paid full registration for both conferences must meet the following conditions:

- All requests will be verified using registration records for both events.
- Rebates will be paid by one of the following methods:
 - If a credit card was used to pay registration, the rebate will be credited to the same account.
 - If a check was used to pay registration, a rebate check will be made payable to the same party.
 - If cash was used to pay registration, a check will be issued in the name of the attendee.
- Rebates may take up to four weeks to process.
